## Capital Campaign Update et al.

Thanks to the generous families who contributed towards the diocesan capital campaign, St. Joseph exceeded its goal--by 45%--we are at 145%. There have been \$192,765 in pledges made. St. Ann Parish is at \$6,500 in pledges towards its goal of \$18,000. Overall, this was an overwhelming show of generosity. This means that for St. Joseph, by the end of the campaign in five years, a total of \$56,636 should come back to us and go towards our Church renovation work. Our appreciation goes out to Deacon Dennis Kutach and the Campaign Committee here at the parish for their generous willingness to provide leadership and assistance that led to such success!

In the next few weeks it is hoped that the St. Ann Pavilion project will begin once all of the required paperwork is in order. It is a 40x60 metal building with stucco accented front, containing a handicapped equipped restroom, storage area and small kitchenette. The main body of the pavilion will have three pull down doors on each side (6 total). It should be large enough to serve our simple needs and dress up our church grounds as well--all in all, hopefully something to be proud of in the future!

We are in the midst of gathering bids for the St. Joseph Church work and the hope is that by early spring we will have an idea of overall cost. Then we will have to begin our own local financial planning.
